

TEST CREATION

You're the teacher . . . so you should have all the answers, right? Follow the directions to create a masterpiece of an exam for your classmates to take and to prove your knowledge of this material.

Step 1: Make sure you've read and completed chapter 5 & 6 study guide questions . . . this will be tough if you haven't done that yet.

Step 2: Put your teacher shoes on and pretend that you are going to write a test that assesses the knowledge of your students. You'll need to think creatively and develop questions that determine whether they know the content.

Step 3: Create various test questions following these rules. It can be hand-written or typed.

- 15 Multiple Choice: A-D options, no goofy options
- 15 Matching: you can break these up into 1, 2, or 3 separate groups
- 10 True/False
- 10 Short Answer: can be a single word response to a phrase
- 5 Free Response: should be a complete answer with full sentence structure that fully addresses the question.

Step 4: Create a separate answer key that one can use to correct the test.
